The November meeting of A Cappella boosters was held Tuesday, November 7, 2011 in the choir room. Minutes were reviewed and a treasurer's report was given. There is currently a balance of \$31,469.68 with many upcoming trip expenses. It was also reported that our car washes earned \$2812.68 (seniors – \$1302.90, juniors - \$571.78, and sophomores - \$938.00). Shelby Nuckolls reported that the fruit sale ended today and her team of volunteers have been counting and checking orders. Fruit will be delivered on December 2 and everyone who sold fruit will need to pick it up and deliver orders at this time. Many volunteers will be needed to unload the truck and separate orders on that Friday.

Orlando plans are underway. Chaperones must have had a background check from Wood County Schools before they can go with the choir. If you have done this in the past, you do not need to go through the process again. Forms can be obtained from Jo Nichols or at the Board Office.
