PLEASE PROVIDE:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-5 photos of your senior student showing development from infancy to today. • Electronic (jpg or bmp) is preferred; • Hard copy is OK if you don't have a scanner, but <u>sooner rather than later</u> for hard copies. • Photos will be returned. • Please clearly label any CDs you burn or any photos you provide with your name.
BY:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wednesday, April 20 OR BEFORE. • Before is very good, especially if you're providing actual hard-copy photos.

TIPS:	<p>The fun part of the Senior Show is to keep the audience guessing as to who is depicted until the child actually becomes recognizable to fellow choir members. Pick and choose wisely!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May I suggest: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A baby photo 2. A toddler photo 3. An elementary era photo 4. A middle school era photo 5. A senior photo • Embarrassing can be funny, but make sure your student will be OK with the laughter. Always keep your student's personality in mind. • It can be fun to keep the selection of photos from your student so it's a surprise even to her or him. • Individual photos are best. The show is about your student, not friends and family. • I usually crop extra people out of most photos unless you tell me otherwise. So, If a grandparent/parent/sibling is of immense importance to your student and you want to use a photo with several people in it, please note that.
ABOUT SENIOR PHOTOS:	<p>Most students and parents want to use a senior portrait for the A Cappella Senior Show. That's great, but timeliness is critical. Here's what I suggest:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If senior photos are in hand by the April 20 deadline, great! • If senior photos are NOT available by the deadline but you EXPECT them to be done by May 4, that's OK. But PLEASE do the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Provide an acceptable photo (that you can live with) in place of the senior photo ○ Note that you'll deliver the correct senior photo by May 4. ○ Can't guarantee I can substitute photos after that date ...
